

QFHT FEE SCHEDULE FOR UNINSURED SERVICES

Ontario Health Insurance Program (OHIP) does not reimburse QFHT for certain medical services. Examples include: visits without a valid OHIP card; Canada Revenue Agency Disability Tax Credit Certificates; completion of certain forms (parking permits, forms for work/school); request for medical supplies; and cosmetic procedures.

Fees for uninsured services will be invoiced directly to the patient. (Interac, VISA and MasterCard are accepted, but we cannot accept cash or personal cheques.) Exceptions will be made in circumstances of financial hardship or if a patient has coverage from a “third-party” such as UHIP, WSIB or legal representation.

Please note that patients with an expired OHIP card will be invoiced \$50 two weeks after an appointment if an updated OHIP version code has not been provided to the receptionist in the interim. Patients who miss an appointment (“no shows”) without 24 hours’ notice will be invoiced \$10. If this presents a financial problem, please speak to your receptionist.

If you have financial concerns or questions regarding these fees, please notify the receptionist or speak with your physician, prior to the service being performed. (Effective August 1, 2017)
